Clarification of the "Believe, Belong, and Become" language is critically important. Discipleship is ministry, not a membership or leadership tactic.

Believe: maximizing opportunities to disciple people to believe.

- Membership condition #1
  - \* Confession of faith in Jesus Christ as evidenced by an inner witness of new birth through the Holy Spirit and a commitment to pursue holiness in all things.
- Membership condition #2
  - \* Christian baptism.

**Belong:** strengthening relationships to invite and instruct believers to belong.

- Membership condition #3
  - \* Instruction in, acceptance of, and a commitment to abide by The Articles of Religion, the Elementary Principles, and the authority of The Wesleyan Church in matters of church government.

**Become:** referencing *Guides and Helps to Holy Living* (260-268, *Discipline*) for each individual's spiritual growth that may result in positional leadership. Leadership training should allow its participants the choice of assuming a position or serving without title.

- Membership condition #4
  - \* Commitment to live out the mission and vision of The Wesleyan Church through a discipling relationship within the local church.

"How will we recognize success? Success occurs every time a disciple makes a disciple and a church multiplies itself." Dr. Wayne Schmidt
